

HIV & Hepatitis C Testing Services for Contra Costa Residents

October 2017

1. **Your medical provider.** Under the Affordable Care Act, HIV & Hepatitis C (HCV) testing is covered at no cost as a prevention service. Please ask your primary care provider for an HIV/HCV antibody test.
2. **Public Health HIV/AIDS & STD Program:** We offer free rapid HIV/HCV testing to high-risk individuals at the following locations:
 - **El Cerrito:** Rainbow Community Center 6491 Portola Drive El Cerrito, CA
Free testing is provided on the first and third Monday of the month from 4-8 pm
 - **Richmond:**
Familias Unidas 205 39th St. Richmond, CA
Free testing is provided every first and third Wednesday of the month from 1-4 pm.

Native American Health Center, 2566 McDonald Ave @ 26th St. Richmond, CA
Free testing is provided every second and fourth Friday from 1-4 pm.
 - **Concord:** Rainbow Community Center 2118 Willow Pass Rd., Suite 500
Free testing is provided every Tuesday of the month from 4-8pm.
 - **Concord:** Todos Santos Plaza
Free testing is provided on the first Tuesday of the month from 10-2:30 pm, look for the white Contra Costa County van near the corner of Willow Pass Rd. and Mt. Diablo St.
Anonymous testing is offered at this site.
 - **Antioch:** 18th at A Street. (next to Starbucks)
Free testing is provided every fourth Wednesday of the month from 1-4 pm. Look for the white Contra Costa County van.
- We use OraQuick test kits: for HIV it can be done by fingerstick or oral swab and for HCV it can only be done by fingerstick. Results for both in 20 minutes. Call (925) 313-6771 for information.
3. **Contra Costa Health Services STD Clinics.** Free rapid HIV testing is offered at:
 - West County Health Center, first and third Thursday from 5-7:30 pm.
 - Concord Health Center, second and fourth Tuesday from 5-7:30 pm.
 - Pittsburg Health Center, first and third Wednesday from 5:30-8 pm.
4. **Planned Parenthood.** Rapid HIV testing is offered at all of their clinics in Contra Costa County. May have a cost depending on insurance coverage and/or income. Use Trinity test kit, fingerstick only, results in 10 minutes. Anonymous and confidential testing is offered by appointment, please call 1-800-230-7526.
5. **Cal-PEP:** After hours and evening rapid HIV community testing in Richmond, Bay Point, Pittsburg, and Antioch. Please call (510) 874-7850 ext. 8766 for locations.
