The Contra Costa Environmental Health Division of the Contra Costa County Health Services Department, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. The WCCSL Organic Materials Processing Facility ("Facility") operates under Solid Waste Facility Permit No. 07-AA-0044, issued by the LEA on May 26, 2010. On April 19, 2016, the LEA received an application from the Facility operator for an amendment to the Report of Facility Information (RFI). The RFI, a document that describes the design and operation of a solid waste facility, is a required component of an application for a solid waste facility permit.

As required by Section 21660.1 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, the LEA is distributing this notice for the purpose of noticing the acceptance of the amendments to the RFI application package on April 20, 2016.

Description of Proposed Changes

The RFI amendments provide additional description for the aerated static pile composting process and current permits from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District.

LEA Determination

The LEA has determined that the proposed changes are acceptable and consistent with the applicable State Minimum Standards, do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current Solid Waste Facility Permit, and are consistent with the Facility's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) analysis. Pursuant to Section 21665(c) of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, the LEA approved the RFI amendments on April 20, 2016.
