



Contra Costa Coordinated Entry 2017 RFP Awards

We are pleased to announce awards of a number of components Coordinated Entry system in Contra Costa County for 2017. We expect these components to launch in early 2018.

CARE Center (West County)

Greater Richmond Interfaith Program (GRIP) will operate the West County Coordinated Assessment Resource (CARE) Center at the Greater Richmond Interfaith Program (GRIP) Souper Center site (165 S. 22nd Street in Richmond). This site will continue to offer basic needs (shower facilities, food), assessments and referrals and will also offer enhanced case management services, document assistance (credit checks, IDs, birth certificates) as well as flexible space for co-located services and substance use disorder treatment through Drug Medi-Cal. The center will be open Monday- Friday from 8:00 am – 5 pm.

Prevention & Diversion Assessment and Referral Services

The **Hume Center** will provide centralized assessment and referral support for clients in need of diversion services. The agency will provide homelessness diversion counseling family mediation services, landlord/tenant conflict resolution and brief, goal-oriented case management

Housing Location

Hamilton Family Center will provide housing location services as part of Coordinated Entry. Services will include marketing to identify landlords and build inventory, landlord outreach and identification of vacant housing units, and coordinating with housing navigation services to connect clients to housing.
