

Family PACT

What Is Family PACT?

Family PACT is a health program that provides family planning and other health services to low-income adults and teens in California

Who Is Eligible?

Adults & teens who meet income guidelines and do not have insurance that covers family planning OR have insurance, but need to keep family planning services confidential

How Much Does It Cost?

There is NO COST for Family PACT services.

Healthy Families

What Is Healthy Families?

Healthy Families is a comprehensive health insurance for low and middle-income children in California.

Who Is Eligible?

- Children under the age of 19 who are not eligible for no-cost Medi-Cal
- Citizenship or legal residency is required

How Much Does It Cost?

\$6-\$17 per month per child;
\$51 per month maximum

Health Coverage Initiative

What Is Health Coverage Initiative?

A temporary health coverage program that provides comprehensive health services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Health Centers. With prior authorization, health care may be provided at La Clínica de La Raza, or Brookside Community Health Centers.

Who Is Eligible?

Residents of Contra Costa County who meet the following criteria:

- Ineligible for Medi-Cal, Healthy Families or any other health insurance
- Uninsured for at least for three months prior to applying
- Household gross income is not greater than 200% of Federal Poverty Guideline
- A U.S. Citizen or legal permanent resident who has resided in the U.S. continuously for five years or longer
- Persons 19 to 64 years of age

How Much Does It Cost?

\$0-\$75 per quarter

Medi-Cal

What Is Medi-Cal?

Medi-Cal is health insurance for low-income families, seniors and disabled adults in California.

Who Is Eligible?

- Adults 65 years or older.
- Adults who have any children under 21 years of age living in their home
- Children through age 21 may be eligible.

How Much Does It Cost?

There is NO COST for Full-Scope Medi-Cal.

Private Health Insurance

Contra Costa Health Plan

Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan

Low cost health coverage for children birth to 18 years old who are not eligible for Medi-Cal or Healthy Families, or health care coverage that is paid for, in any part, by an employer.

Medicare

What is Medicare?

Medicare is a federal health insurance program for persons aged 65 and older, and persons under 65 years of age who are disabled or have End Stage Renal Disease (kidney failure). Medicare Part A covers hospital insurance, Part B covers medical insurance and Part D covers prescription drugs.

Who is Eligible?

Persons:

- Must be 65 years of age or older
- Have End Stage Renal Disease (kidney failure)
- Under 65 and receiving Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) for 24 months or greater
- Must be a U.S. citizen or qualified immigrant living in the U.S. continuously for five years with the requisite work history

How Much Does It Cost?

- Most do not pay for Part A (hospital)
- \$96.50 per month for Part B (medical)
- Various costs for Medicare Part D (prescription drugs)

Child Health and Disability Prevention Program (CHDP)

What Is CHDP?

CHDP is a preventive health program that provides periodic preventative exams, and helps to make early health care available to all children. CHDP works with families to:

- Set up regular preventive exams for infants, children, and adolescents
- Coordinate necessary health services for identified problems

Who Is Eligible?

- Children on Medi-Cal ages 0-20
- Uninsured children up to the age of 19 who meet income guidelines

What is the CHDP Gateway?

CHDP Gateway is an electronic enrollment for temporary Medi-Cal for up to 60 days. The gateway permits the parents of uninsured children to apply for temporary Medi-Cal during a wellness visit to a CHDP doctor. The parents will receive an application mailed to their home to apply for continuing Medi-Cal for their child(ren).

How Much Does It Cost?

There is NO COST for CHDP services if you meet the income guidelines or are on Medi-Cal.

Basic Health Care

What Is Basic Health Care?

Basic Health Care is a county-sponsored health coverage program that provides comprehensive health care services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and its Health Centers.

Who Is Eligible?

- Families living in Contra Costa County who:
 - meet asset guidelines and income is not greater than 300% of the Federal Poverty Guideline.
 - do not have health insurance
 - are not eligible for Full-Scope Medi-Cal or Healthy Families
- Adults who are U.S. Citizen or legal permanent resident.
- U.S. citizenship or permanent legal resident not required for children 18 years of age or younger.

How Much Does It Cost?

- \$0-\$15 every three months for children 18 years old and under
- \$0-\$225 every three months for adults
