A3 is an innovative approach to provide timely and appropriate behavioral health crisis services to *anyone, anywhere* at *anytime* in Contra Costa County. A3 team members triage crisis calls, provide field-based mental health crisis intervention and peer support; and connect people in crisis and their families to services.

- » Have lived experience — you or a family member are living with a mental health condition or are in recovery from a mental health condition or substance use disorder
- » Are familiar with methods of wellness, recovery and resiliency in mental health and/or substance use
- » Have experience working and interacting with people from diverse cultural and linguistic groups
- » Are a graduate of SPIRIT, NAMI Basics or Family-to-Family, Alameda County BestNOW! or Community Action Marin Mental Health Peer Education Program
