

If you are a Contra Costa County Medi-Cal beneficiary and if you think you or a family member needs substance use services, call the Access Line at **1-800-846-1652** (toll free). For those who are hearing/speech impaired, call the California Relay Service (CRS) at 711 (TTH/TDD). The Behavioral Health Access Line will conduct a screening and referral to a DMC-ODS Plan provider who will perform an assessment to determine medical necessity based on the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) criteria. If necessary, the Access Line provides authorization for residential treatment.
