ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ❑ Advanced the County's Social Host Ordinance ([link](#))
- ❑ Sustained the Youth, Family and Community System of Care
- ❑ Created and Developed 5 Alcohol Policy Working Group Coalitions
- ❑ The West County Alcohol Policy Working Group with support from the City of Richmond passed the Retail Licensing program
- ❑ Window decals were designed by the Anti-Drug and Alcohol Monument Corridor Coalition: "Not Selling Alcohol to Minors" and placed in all local stores in Concord
- ❑ 3 Responsible Beverage Serving Trainings were conducted
- ❑ Numerous input and recommendations were provided to local planning commissions and police departments on new and existing alcohol licenses
- ❑ Completed Special Events Assessment by the East County Alcohol Policy Coalition to determine compliance with sales of alcohol at various community events in Antioch (County Fair), Brentwood (Corn Festival), Pittsburg (Seafood Festival)
- ❑ Co-sponsored with the Alcohol and Other Drugs Advisory Board the Marijuana Educational Series and formulated recommendations to the Board of Supervisors
- ❑ Development of a Photovovela and 3 different posters highlighting Shoulder Tapping and Youth Access to Alcohol. Posters were placed on 4 different bus shelters.
- ❑ Youth Leadership programs such as: Friday Night Live, Discovering the Reality of Our Community conducted Town Hall Meetings to raise awareness about Underage Drinking and Youth Access to Alcohol
- ❑ The Monument Anti-Drug and Alcohol Coalitions instituted the Merchant Award program to recognize responsible outlets
- ❑ Implementation of the Screening and Brief Intervention components to enhance services delivered by education strategies and increase the number of screenings
