

# Prehospital Credential Review Process

## I. PURPOSE

This policy identifies the process for prehospital credential review.

## II. EMT

All investigations and disciplinary actions shall be conducted in accordance with California HSC, CCR Title 22, Division 9, Chapter 6, California Model Disciplinary Orders for EMTs and advanced EMTs, Title 2, Division 3, Part 1, Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500), Title 1, Division 4, Chapter 9.6 (Commencing with Section 3250) of the California Government Code when the certificate holder is a firefighter and Title 1, Division 4, Chapter 9.7 (Commencing with Section 3300) of the California Government Code when the certificate holder is a peace officer.

## III. PARAMEDIC

All evaluations of disciplinary cause, temporary suspension orders, ineligibility for local accreditation in accordance with CCCEMSA policy, shall be conducted in accordance with California HSC and CCR. Title 22, Division 9, Chapter 4.

## IV. MICN

Action on MICN authorization may be imposed by the LEMSA Medical Director based upon the finding of an imminent threat to the public's health and safety as evidenced by the occurrence of any of the items listed in H&SC, Division 2.5, Chapter 7, Section 1798.200(c).
