On June 22, HUD released its [Notice of Funding Opportunity \(NOFO\) for the 2022 Continuum of Care \(CoC\) Supplemental to Address Unsheltered and Rural Homelessness \(Special NOFO\)](#) Competition. After receiving community input during the August 4<sup>th</sup> Council on Homelessness meeting and securing technical assistance, Contra Costa CoC is prepared to facilitate a competition to apply for this funding.

If you are interested in applying for this funding, **please join us for the Contra Costa CoC's mandatory informational Technical Assistance (TA) Workshop on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 from 1:30 - 3:00pm via Zoom.** We apologize for the short notice but the competition timeframe is short and our community was only recently able to secure additional capacity to apply to this competition. The Special NOFO only funds new projects. This workshop will provide information about project applications to address unsheltered homelessness through Permanent Housing, Rapid Rehousing, or Support Services Only projects. **We encourage all organizations interested in applying for CoC funding to attend, including organizations that have not previously received CoC funding.**

The Special NOFO funds projects for a three-year period and the total allocation awarded to Contra Costa CoC is \$5,368,828.

Please note that this amount is not necessarily indicative of what will be available this year.

The following entities are eligible to apply as recipients or subrecipients of Continuum of Care funding:

- Nonprofit providers,
- States,
- Instrumentalities of state and local governments,
- Public housing agencies,
- Indian Tribes or tribally designated housing entities (as defined in section 4 of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (25 U.S.C. 4103) (TDHEs)), and
- Local governments.
