

## 2019 Point in Time

Annual snapshot of Homelessness in Contra Costa County

**3%** 61 more persons counted in 2019 than in 2018.



668 persons sheltered



- 11% families (62 households)
- 89% single adults



1,627 persons unsheltered



- 3% families (37 households)
- 97% single adults

- Unmet need


**28%** Percent of single adults can be served by available shelters

14% one-year increase




15% (n=165) one-year decrease in adults 62+

For persons sleeping outside, current episode of homelessness ranged


