**REPORT:**

At approximately 15:00, Mr. Jim Powell from City of Antioch Public Works contacted CCHSHMP. Mr. Powell stated that there were 5x55 gallons drums illegally disposed at the end of F street in Antioch. Mr. Powell stated that the drums were placed near the storm drain. Three of the drums seemed to be full. One was half full, and one was empty. Two drums were laid on their sides, and three drums were upright. Two drums had motor oil 5-30w labels. Two drums had Ecolab and Perform on their labels. One drum had no label. Mr. Powell stated that one drum might have leaked or be leaking. Mr. Powell requested CCHSHMP to investigate and pick up these drums. CCHSHMP departed the office at approximately 15:37. CCHSHMP arrived on scene at approximately 16:16. CCHSHMP observed 5x55 gallons drums. CCHSHMP observed that three of the drums seemed to be full. One was half full, and one was empty. No leak was observed. After a visual investigation, CCHSHMP presumed that 4 drums were contained waste oil and one drum was empty. CCHSHMP moved five drums on HM 4 to temporary storage for proper disposal. CCHSHMP placed a hazardous waste label on each drum. CCHSHMP departed the scene at approximately 17:04. No PCB and chlorinated tests were performed.
