REPORT:

9/5/2018: This called was initially received by CCHSHMP. Per caller, the two buckets were initially found on the sidewalk; but today, the buckets were moved onto the caller's property/yard. Her grandson looked into the contents of the buckets and presumed that it is used oil. The caller is disabled and unable to take the buckets to an authorized facility.

CCHSHMP spoke with Captain Ochoa of Station 87 Pittsburg. The residence is within Contra Costa County Fire's jurisdiction. It was decided that HM21 would be deployed along with CCHSHMP's HM4 to look into the bucket's contents and discuss eventual disposal.

13:10 - The dispatch from Con Fire was received indicating that Con Fire is responding to the abandonment.

13:14 - 1214 (Williams) and 1222 (Heller) departed the office in HM4/6131 to the incident location.

13:23 - After contacting Con Fire Dispatch, HM4 was attached to the list of responding units to the same incident.

13:38 - HM4 arrived on scene with HM21.

13:47 - Joint investigation (CCHSHMP/Con Fire) of two buckets was underway.

CCHSHMP and Con Fire determined that the two buckets contained old used oil in that the used oil was so thick and not fluid. The used oil was subject to the Chlor-D-Tect test to check for chlorinated compounds; the used oil tested negative. CCHSHMP brought back the two 5-gallon buckets of used oil for eventual disposal.(92

14:30 - HM4 departed from scene.
