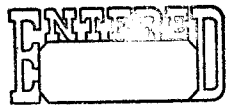

REPORT:

16:15 - Contra Costa HazMat Team (HazMat) received notification from Sheriff's Dispatch.
16:17 - HazMat called Sheriff's Dispatch - oil on roadway at Nortonville Road at Kirkerpass Road leaking towards a creek, Deputy Byrne is standing by at scene.
16:19 - HazMat called Deputy Byrne, there are 8 jugs of what looks like used oil. Two of the jugs have been tipped over and leaked about 20' toward the creek
16:22 - HazMat paged a response is needed. HMS Dempsey directly to scene in POV, HMS Dwight and Lewis to office.
16:32 - HMS Dempsey on scene, provides photo to team and reports release to CalOES.
17:00 - HMS Dwight and Lewis depart office in HM3
17:21 - HMS Dwight and Lewis on scene. After a safety briefing and ICS 208 completed, the buckets were accessed. Liquid that appeared to be used oil was transferred to a 30 gallon drum, except for the darker material that appeared thicker than the other buckets of liquid and the sudsy liquid with dark material, which were transferred to separate 5 gallon buckets. Oily debris, including the emptied 5-gallon buckets, were transferred to a 55 gallon drum and 30 gallon drum. Absorbent was applied to the area of released liquid. Contaminated soil and used absorbent were placed into both drums. All containers were labeled as hazardous waste.
18:22 - After completing bill of lading, HMS Dempsey and HM3 depart scene.
18:55 - HM3 returns to office. Containers with hazardous materials were offloaded into hazardous waste storage area and testing was conducted for chlorinated contamination of the liquid. Testing was negative - no chlorinated content.
19:30 - HMS Dwight and Lewis depart office.
