REPORT:

At 9:28 AM, East Contra Costa Fire District (ECCFD) requested Contra Costa Health Services Hazardous Materials Programs (CCHSHMP) to respond to an Amtrak train and a semi truck collision at a crossing in Knightsen.

At 9:37 AM, DV en-routed to scene.

At 9: 48 AM, AS en-routed to scene.

At 10:03, HM1 (JP) departed the office.

At 10:15 AM, DV arrived on scene. DV assessed the scene. Tow trucks enrouted to scene. DV observed that ECCFD created dirt barrier for spilled oil and Diesel. No injuries were observed. DV determined that it was a clean up operation at that point. DV was informed that BNSF contracted the clean up contractor for the clean up operation and spill prevention. The clean up contractor enrouted.

At 10:30 AM, HM3 (MD and DWL) departed the office.

At 10:44 AM, HM1 arrived on scene.

At 10:49 AM, AS arrived on scene.

At 11:10 AM, HM3 arrived on scene.

CCHSHMP observed that there was one damaged saddle tank and the other saddle tank was intact. The hydraulic fluid tank was intact. CCHSHMP discussed with Mr. Larry Bohringer, Truck Driver. Mr. Bohringer stated that there were about total of 100 gallons of Diesel inside both saddle fuel tanks and approximately 50 gallons of hydraulic fluid inside a fluid tank before the accident. AS and MD removed the diesel content inside a damaged saddle tank. CCHSHMP recovered about 50 gallons of Diesel from the damaged saddle tank. CCHSHMP disconnected the siphon hose(s) and other fluid hose feeding to the damaged saddle tank. CCHSHMP was not able to determine the remaining quantities of Diesel inside the intact saddle tank and the hydraulic fluid tank. CCHSHMP observed that motor oil, antifreeze, Diesel, and hydraulic fluid were spilled on the railway, to the river bank and to the Old River in Knightsen. Unknown amount of the spill or release was noted. The amount of release to the Old River was unrecoverable. CCHSHMP observed a small petroleum sheen area on the Old River. CCHSHMP observed that US Ecology and NRC deployed brooms on the Old River near the incident location to prevent and catch any spills releasing from the clean up operation. CCHSHMP referred the clean up operation to DFW. DFW would oversee the clean up operation. US Ecology would manage the disposal of the hazardous wastes.

At 12:40 PM, AS departed from scene.

At 01:31 PM, HM1, HM3 and DV departed from scene.
