### REPORT:

#### 7/16/2021:

At approx 10:00AM the SFIC Corp facility manager Sam Ryerson contacted CCHS - HMP to report a spill that entered the storm drain, CCHS Inspector notified CCC-FPD. CCHS-HMP & CCC-FPD were dispatched to the scene.

CCHS HMP dispatched HM1 (Box Truck) DV + IW. KA arrived later in her personnel vehicle.

Upon arrival CCHS-HMP met to discuss the incident with CCC-FPD Captain Chris Hummel and SFIC facility manager Sam Ryerson.

CCHS-HMP Initial Assessment: Between 70 - 120 gallons of TEA Laury Sulfate (a base material of shampoo and cosmetic) had entered the storm drain.

CCHS-HMP Hazmat Objectives / Operations: CCHS initial objectives were to identify the storm drains, the direction the spilled materials flowed and clean out the storm drains.

CCHS notified City of Concord Public Works CCHS notified CalOES

#### Clean up Operations

City of Concord Public Works Identified the storm drain path using their GIS, then flushed and vacuumed the spilled material inside the storm drain with their vacuum truck.

#### Post Clean up:

After reviewing the SDS the spilled materials was determined to be non-hazardous and the vacuum truck waste was disposed of at City Concord Corp Yard on Gasoline Alley.

CCHS inspector discussed spill prevention BMPs with the facility and requested they purchase a storm drain cover to use during chemical loading / unloading operations.
