Medi-Cal Covers Dental for Former Foster Youth

Medi-Cal has you covered!

Because of the 2010 Affordable Care Act (ACA), if you were in foster care at age 18 or older, you may qualify for full scope Medi-Cal under the Former Foster Youth program. Your Medi-Cal benefits include dental services.

What services am I covered for?

If you are **under the age of 21**, you may be covered for these free or low-cost services:

- Exam*
- Teeth cleaning
- Fillings
- Emergency services
- Molar sealants**
- Orthodontics (braces)***
- Partial and full dentures
- Scaling and root planing

- X-ravs
- Fluoride varnish
- Tooth removal
- Sedation
- Root canals
- Denture relines
- Crowns

If you are age 21 or older, you may be covered for these free or low-cost services:

- Exam*
- Teeth cleaning
- Fillings
- Emergency services
- Root canals

How do I find a dentist who accepts Medi-Cal?

Do I have to apply for dental services?

No. The Medi-Cal program includes dental services. You do not need to apply separately for dental coverage.
