REPORT:

12/13/2022:

Received CalOES State Warning Center notification of a derailment of six (6) railcars coming from Corteva due to "track failure" at 14:39. Around this time, the incident came up on Tablet Command. Shortly after receipt of the notification, I was asked to follow-up with Corteva to get more information on the derailment; I spoke with Fire Chief Robbie Morris. There were discrepancies in reporting of the commodities contained in the derailed railcars between the report from Chief Morris and Tablet Command. The six (6) railcars contained the following: 36% hydrochloric acid (HCI) x 3 (belonging to K2 Pure), 50% sodium hydroxide (NaOH) x 1, empty 500-pound aromatic x 1, and potassium hydroxide (KOH)/caustic water x 1. The railcars were not leaking but that could change when the railcars will get uprighted. Additionally, a contractor to perform uprighting operations was on its way, and at the time of the call, there was no ETA.

I called Fire Dispatch for clarification on the Tablet Command notes, and I was told that they were trying to get a hold of the team. Essentially, Con Fire wanted us out there. The team headed to scene from office prior to 15:30 and arrived 15:48. The team was escorted to Corteva's rail yard from Gate B that is SE of the main gate. The team met up with the Con Fire's team to gather more information on the derailment. Con Fire developed a plume model that indicated a worst-case scenario of an air plume that would reach the shopping area in Antioch off Somersville. HMS John Pham had a discussion with their Tech Ref that the scenario is unlikely if the HCl and NaOH were to mix. Both teams received a debrief from Chief Morris as to the plan to mobilize the railcars to get off the active BSNF line as soon as feasible. The Stockton-based contractor to upright the railcars would begin operation at 01:00 Wednesday morning. Corteva assured that they have contingencies in the event that there is catastrophic failure of a railcar. The team left Corteva and would return in the early morning to monitor the uprighting of the six (6) railcars. Prior to the team's arrival, Corteva updated the CalOES report before 22:30 to report 1/2 gallon spill of KOH (which was cleaned up immediately after discovery) as Railserve was conducting assessments before uprighting operations would take place. The 12:30 crew (HMSs G. Kierstead, N. Menge, J. Pham, and E. Ruane) was relieved at approximately 08:53 by HMSs I. Williams and F. Zappelli. At approximately 12:25, Wednesday, 12/7, the 6th and last railcar was uprighted. The railcars went to their respective yards for further inspection. The incident of the track failure that led to the derailment is under investigation by BNSF.
