REPORT:

Contra Costa County Hazardous Materials Programs (CCCHMP) was notified by Contra Costa County Public Works (CCCPW) that an illegal dumping had occurred in a residential neighborhood in Bay Point. They were on scene to clean it up but found several unlabeled containers and requested CCCHMP assistance.

At 09:25, MD was dispatched to assist CCPW with identifying the waste. MD arrived on scene at 09:50. MD could not be readily identified the waste and requested the team be dispatched with chemical identifying equipment.

Before dispatching the CCCHMP response rig, XB notified the Contra Costa Fire Protection District (Con Fire) of the hazardous waste abandonment. Con Fire dispatched E187 and HM87 to the scene.

At approximately10:45, Con Fire requested CCCHMP assistance. The CCCHMP response rig (HM3) was dispatched along with specialists; XB, DWL, and AS. AS went to the scene in his POV. AS on scene at approximately 11:30 and HM3 on scene at 11:45.

CCCHMP assisted Con Fire and CCCPW identify the waste hazard classes and to transport the corrosives (pH <2.5 and pH >12.5), toxic, and flammable. CCHMP also helped with the clean up of the public street. CCCHMP departed the scene at approximately 13:30.
