Spoke with homeowner of 60 Rolph Park Drive. There is a neighbor down the street having roofing work done. The Deputy came by and the roofers left quickly without securing all their belongings, losing the bucket partway down the street. The roofing material is believed to be a patching material primarily made of asphalt, and smells of asphalt. There is a 5gal bucket that has approximately 1/8th of a bucket or less of material in it, a trash bag with contaminated debris. The largest part of the spill is in the center of the street mostly just to the south side closer to Standish Ct, but a small amount crossing over the middle line and is maybe 200ft long. Most of the material is dry and will be unable to be cleaned up, but some is still wet and being tracked by vehicles, and there is a bucket of material left and contaminated debris.

*Left a message for Public Works on 2 numbers because we will not be able to clean up the entire spill - especially the dried asphalt material.

6:15pm HM4 On Scene (IW/NU)

6:30pm Touched base with Deputy Sakai

CCHSHMP shoveled up as much wet material as possible, used absorbent to ensure any material left on site because it is unable to be removed by shovel was fully dry, and containerized the abandoned debris.

7:00pm CCHSHMP left the scene

*Dried Asphalt is generally not considered hazardous, All resulting debris was removed as solid waste.

10/15/21 CCHSHMP worked with public works to notify them of the spill and what was remaining, in case they had any tools for cleaning the excess asphalt. See attached email thread.
