At 1:00 PM, Contra Costa County Fire Protection District (CONFIRE) requested Contra Costa Health Services Hazardous Materials Programs (CCHSHMP) to respond to an abandoned 55 gallons drum of waste oil and oil spill on the road. At 2:11 PM, HM3 (JP&DV) departed to scene. At 2:32 PM, HM3 arrived on scene. CCHSHMP met Captain Chris Hummel. CONFIRE staff mitigated the oil spill and placed contaminated soil into two (2) 5 gallons poly containers. CONFIRE used the Hazmat ID Elite equipment to identify the content inside the 55 gallons metal drum. The equipment showed Mineral Oil. CCHSHMP visually inspected the drum and determined that it looked like waste oil. CCHSHMP inspected the damaged metal drum. CCHSHMP tested the PCB concentration of the waste oil using Clor-D-Tech. The results showed that the PCB concentration of the waste oil was less than 1000 PPM. CCHSHMP replaced a new lid on the drum and secured the drum. At 3:18 PM, HM3 departed from scene. CCHSHMP transported two 5 gallons poly containers and one 55 gallons metal drum to hazardous waste storage bay.
