- 19:06 CCHS-HMP received a page from Contra Costa County Sheriff Dispatch.
- 19:10 I. Williams of CCHS-HMP contacted Sheriff Dispatch by phone. CCCFPD was on scene at 191 Howe Road, Martinez to investigate a bright green substance in the creek. Battallion Chief Impastato had requested CCHS-HMP to respond.
- 19:23 I. Williams was able to reach B.C. Impastato by phone. CCCFPD responded to an unknown bright green substance in the creek. The substance was believed to be as much as several hundred gallons of antifreeze. CCHS-HMP to respond in HM1 and HM3.
- 19:40 I. Williams spoke by phone en route to office with Captain Ochoa of Station 87 from the scene.
- 19:50 I. Williams arrived at truck bay and began prepping HM1 and HM3.
- 20:12 I. Williams and E. Dempsey departed office in HM1 for scene. K. Abramians and A. Ackerman to follow in HM3.
- 20:17 HM1 arrived on scene at the ICP at 197 Howe Road, Martinez. I. Williams spoke with B.C. Impastato and Bob Chedsey of California Department of Fish and Wildlife. CCCFPD had pulled liquid samples from the creek, but the samples were not showing characteristics of antifreeze-pH tested neutral. CCHS-HMP suggested that the green substance may be a machine tracer dye. The primary concern discussed was in keeping the substance out of the fish spawning grounds downstream in Pacheco Creek. CCHS-HMP agreed to activate Martinez Public Works resources in case an earthen dam was required. HM3 arrived on scene.
- 20:25 I. Williams contacted Martinez Public Works on-call representative and discussed sand bags for an earthen dam. The representative agreed to start working on sand bags.
- 20:44 A. Ackerman and E. Dempsey contacted Mt. View Sanitation District through Sheriff Dispatch. CCHS-HMP asked if the department had used a sewer tracer dye in the vicinity of Howe Road recently. The Mt. View Sanitation District had used 16oz of "Standard Sewer Tracer" earlier that day on Howe Road. CCHS-HMP requested more information and the SDS sheet for the non-hazardous tracer dye (see attached).
- 20:56 CCHS-HMP, CCCFPD, and DFW met to discuss the non-hazardous Norlab Tracer Dye. The plan to dam the creek was canceled.
- 21:00 CCCFPD and DFW departed scene.
- 21:05 I. Williams contacted Brandon at MPW and canceled sand bag support.
- 21:10 I. Williams contacted Sheriff Dispatch and Martinez Police Dispatch to update both agencies on the situation.
- 21:28 HM1 and HM3 departed scene for the office.
- 21:38 HM1 and HM3 arrived at office.
- 21:50 Team rehabilitated equipment.
