Notification:

At approx 0900 CCHSHMP received and responded to a notification from CCCFPD Dispatch of a car that left the roadway and entered Brushy Creek on Vasco Road. The incident resulted in an unknown amount of engine fluids to spill into the waterway.

CCHSHMP dispatched HM2 (box truck) & HM4 (flatbed)

Approx 0930 HMS arrives on scene and notifies OES & F&W Approx 1045 HM2 and HM4 and Arrowhead tow truck arrive on scene

Initial Assessment:

The driver of the car in the creek has been taken to the hospital, vehicle is leaking engine fluids but they are being contained by mud and dirt. It is not safe to perform clean up operations until vehicle has been towed out of the creek. Fire has

Weather Conditions: sunny, hot and dry

Hazmat Operation:

Once tow truck arrived on scene work crews, CHP and property owner East Bay Parks drove on access (dirt) roads and parked along the creek to prep for vehicle removal. Prior to vehicle removal, work crews on scene held a safety briefing, an ASO was assigned, HMS placed boom down stream and prepared absorbent material, air monitoring was deemed not necessary. Vehicle leaked antifreeze and oil, gasoline tank appeared to be intact.

Mitigation:

Once vehicle was out of the creek and a safe distance away HMS cleaned up contaminated area by applying oil absorbent pads in the creek, digging up contaminated dirt and packaging waste in 5 gallon container for transport.

Depart scene approx 1245: Upon completion of vehicle recovery and waste cleanup work crews held a debrief and departed scene.
