8/5/18
 At 19:19 ConFire paged and requested Contra Costa Health Services Hazardous Materials Program (CCHSHMP) to respond to an unknown substance seeping out of the ground.
 At 19:52 HM1 (JP&IW) departed the office.
 At 20:13 HM1 was on scene. HM3 (NU & DV) departed the office.
 CCHSHMP checked in with ConFire Battalion Chief (BC) Jim Huntze and Captain Steve Sawyer. Captain Sawyer was HazMat Group Supervisor. Captain Sawyer stated that ConFire contacted Kinder Morgan to shut down the pump. The release was stopped. The pressure in the pipe line dropped from 1440 PSI to 90 PSI approximately 19:45. ConFire made an entry and collected samples.
 At 20:35, HM3 arrived on scene. CCHSHMP was on scene to support ConFire. Mr. Grant McClellan, Area Manager Concord Station, from Kinder Morgan Inc. stated that the release was from a 12 inches pipe line. Mr. McClellan stated that Kinder Morgan Inc. estimated about 300 gallons of Diesel fuel released. CCHSHMP observed two storm drains on Hillcrest Ave were impacted. The Diesel had migrated to a fall out on the North West side of Hillcrest Ave. Kinder Morgan Inc. crews were on scene to mitigate the release.
 At 22:11 HM3 (DV&NU) departed the scene.

8/6/18
 At 0:22 HM1 (JP&IW) departed the scene.

8/7/18
 CCHSHMP contacted Mr. McClellan for the update information. Mr. McClellan stated that Kinder Morgan is still working to mitigate the release. Kinder Morgan cleaned the storm drains, removed the Diesel spill, removed most of contaminated soil, cleaned the affected road, and paved the road. CCHSHMP contacted Mr. Mark Bare, Engineering Geologist, from Site Cleanup Program - Department of Defense Unit of Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (VRWQCB). Mr. Bare stated that VRWQCB will oversee the clean up.
