RP STATES A VEHICLE ROLL OVER ACCIDENT CAUSING SEVERAL CONTAINERS OF POOL CHEMICALS TO BE THROWN FROM THE VEHICLE ONTO THE HIGHWAY AND ARE LAYING THE ROADWAY. CONTRA COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT IS ON SCENE MAKING AN ASSESSMENT.

**REPORT:**

CONTRA COSTA HEALTH SERVICES HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE TEAM (CCHSHMT) RECEIVED A PAGE FROM CONTRA COSTA COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (CON FIRE) TO ASSIST WITH THE EVALUATION AND MITIGATION OF A POTENTIAL CHEMICAL SPILL ON SOUTHBOUND INTERSTATE 680 HIGHWAY, MARTINEZ, CALIFORNIA AT 08:22. CCHSHMT RESPONDED WITH SIX TEAM MEMBERS XB, DL, DWL, KA, TJ, AND DV.

AT 08:41 CCHMRT ARRIVED ON SCENE AND OBSERVED THAT TWO VEHICLES WERE IN AN ACCIDENT. ONE OF THE VEHICLES WAS A SMALL POOL SUPPLY FORD PICK-UP TRUCK AND THE OTHER VEHICLE APPEARED TO BE A NISSAN COMPACT CAR. THE PICK-UP WAS OVER TURNED BEHIND THE CAR. THE POOL CHEMICALS, APPARENTLY BEING STORED AND TRANSPORTED IN THE BACK OF THE TRUCK WERE OBSERVED SCATTERED ACROSS THE HIGHWAY. SEVERAL OF THE CONTAINERS WERE OBSERVED TO BE BROKEN. THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL (CHP) HAD LIMITED THRU TRAFFIC TO ONE OR TWO LANES.

CCHSHMRT AND CON FIRE DETERMINED BASED ON THE CHEMICALS BEING TRANSPORTED AND THE BROKEN CONDITION OF SEVERAL OF THE CHEMICAL CONTAINERS, THERE WAS A POTENTIAL FOR THE CHEMICALS TO MIX TO FORM CHLORINE GAS AND POTENTIALLY HARMING THE RESPONDERS. RECOGNITION AND CLEAN UP WAS PERFORMED IN LEVEL B - TYCHEM AND SCBA. A JOINT ENTRY WITH CCHSHMT AND CON FIRE WAS CONDUCTED. THE TEAM WHEN IN WITH CHLORINE GAS BADGES TO MONITOR FOR CHLORINE. ALTHOUGH THE TEAM WAS USING BOTTLES, IF CHLORINE WAS DETECTED (DEPENDING ON WIND DIRECTION) IF COULD AFFECT THE COMMAND POST. A CHLORINE GAS BADGE WAS DEPLOYED IN THE COMMAND POST. NO CHLORINE WAS DETECTED, HOWEVER A SLIGHT BLEACH SMELL WAS NOTICED CLOSER TO THE ACCIDENT. THE ENTRY TEAM BADGE DID ALARM. BECAUSE NO CHEMICAL MIXING WAS OBSERVED, SENTIMENT WAS THAT IT WAS DETECTING THE BLEACH (NOT CHLORINE GAS) THE CHP CLOSED THE REMAINING OPEN LANES WHILE THE CLEAN UP OCCURED.

POOL CHEMICALS OBSERVED RELEASED INCLUDED BLEACH, MURIATIC ACID, SODIUM BICARBONATE, CYANURIC ACID, AND DIATOMACEOUS EARTH. THE MAJOR CONCERN (ALTHOUGH SMALL) WAS THE MIXING OF THE BLEACH AND THE MURIATIC ACID WOULD GENERATE CHLORINE GAS. ALTHOUGH THERE IS A SMALL AMOUNT OF METAL OXIDES IN THE DIATOMACEOUS EARTH AND MIXING A METAL OXIDE WITH ACID WILL GENERATE HYDROGEN GAS, THE RISK WAS VERY SMALL AND GREATLY OUTWEIGHED BY THE POTENTIAL GENERATION OF CHLORINE.

THE ENTRY TEAM OBSERVED THAT THE CHEMICALS WERE RELEASED, HOWEVER THE CHEMICALS WERE NOT OBSERVED TO HAVE MIXED. THE SPILLED CHEMICALS HAD EITHER EVAPORATED OR SEEPED INTO THE ROAD. NO LIQUID MITIGATION WAS CONDUCTED. SODIUM BICARBONATE SPILL WAS SWEEPED UP AND CONTAINED. THE CHEMICAL CONTAINERS WERE COLLECTED AND MOVED OUT OF THE ROADWAY. CHEMICALS STILL IN THE CONTAINERS WERE DEEMED USABLE AND THE EMPTY CONTAINERS WERE COMPLETELY EMPTY AND SMALLER THAN 5 GALLON. THEREFORE THE MATERIALS WERE NOT HAZARDOUS WASTE. SALVAGED CHEMICALS WERE RETURNED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE RP.

ENTRY TEAM WAS DECONTAMINATED WITH SOAP AND WATER AND TESTED WITH PH AND OXIDER PAPER. NO CONTAMINATION WAS DETECTED ON THE TEAM.

CCHSHMRT DEPARTED THE SCENE AT 10:38
