14:25 - Contra Costa County Health Hazardous Materials Programs (CCHMP) team is requested by San Ramon Valley Fire Department (SRVFD) to respond to a big rig accident. Five hazardous materials specialists (NU, XB, AA, SD, DL) respond.

15:20 - CCHMP arrives on scene. The overturned tractor trailer that was hauling sand is located at the following GPS coordinates: 37.7734303 -121.8190561 The driver, Jose Jeronimo Hernandez (DL# N379639) is standing on the shoulder of the road. The truck is owned by a business, Cecil Gunite.

During clean up operations, 2 drums (55 gal) of oily debris were generated along with a 55 gallon drum of liquid waste. In addition to that, a lead acid battery was hauled off for disposal.

18:23 - CCHMP depart the scene and the road is re-opened.
