REPORT:

At approximately 8:26 AM, Con Fire dispatch requested CCHSHMP's assistance to respond a vehicle accident. The dispatcher stated that the vehicle was on fire and leaking fuel to the storm drain. CCHSHMP departed the bay at approximately 8:44 AM. CCHSHMP arrived on scene at approximately 8:56 AM. CCHSHMP met with Con Fire Captain Damon Haas and CHP Officer Denise Gallegos. Capt. Haas stated that the Fire Department put out the fire on the vehicle. The driver told Capt. Haas that the fuel tank was about half full. Capt. Haas estimated that there might be approximately up to 10 gallons of gasoline in the fuel tank. Some of the gasoline was burnt during the fire; some of the gasoline was mixed with water and fire fighting foam-water and was released to the storm water capture system on Evora Rd. CHP Officer Gallegos stated that only one person was injured. The driver and the injured person went to John Muir Hospital.

CCHSHMP used a PID to monitor the volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in storm drains and a surface ditch. At approximately 9:00 AM, CCHSHMP measured at approximately 1 parts per million (ppm) in the ditch nearest the burnt vehicle. At approximately 9:08 AM, CCHSHMP measured at approximately 2 ppm at a storm drain at the intersection of St. Tropez Way and Evora Road. At approximately 9:10 AM, CCHSHMP measured at approximately 0 ppm at a storm drain near the intersection of Mota Drive and Azores Circle. At approximately 9:14 AM, CCHSHMP measured at approximately 15 ppm at storm drain on Evora road downhill approximately 150 meters from the incident and on the opposite side of the street from the accident.

CCHSHMP notified Cal OES and generated report number 17-2407 at 9:08.

At approximately 9:19 AM, Con Fire dropped 500 gallons of clean water into the storm drain on Evora Rd nearest to the accident. At approximately 9:28 AM, CCHSHMP observed the water reached the storm drain at the bottom of hill about one quarter of a mile from the dropping location. At approximately 9:30 AM, CCHSHMP also found that the soil at the bottom of the culvert located at Mota Drive and Evora Rd was impacted from the release. CCHSHMP measured at approximately 350 ppm of VOC near the surface of the soil. CCHSHMP noted that Con Fire made an earth dam at the bottom of the convert that the vehicle was burning on top of. At 9:40 AM, CHP required IC shift change and CCHSHMP briefed Sergeant Eric Butawan (new CHP IC). At 9:45 AM, CCHSHMP measured at approximately 1.7 ppm at storm drain crossing Evora road, which was previously measure at 15 ppm at 9:14 AM indicating that the flush was effective to move the slug of gasoline.

CCHSHMP mitigated the soil at the bottom of the culvert located at Mota Drive and Evora Rd. Following mitigation actions CCHSHMP measured that the surface of the soil was at approximately 8 ppm indicating effective treatment. CCHSHMP reported incident details to both DFW and USCG at each agency's request. At approximately 10:20 AM, CCHSHMP evaluated that the impacted areas and determined that they were no longer in danger of generating a flammable atmosphere. At approximately 10:25, CCHSHMP departed the scene.
