



## **REPORT:**

On April 22, 2017 CCHS HMP was contacted by Contra Costa Environmental Health about a spill in a creek at the above address in Martinez. CCHS HMP contacted Fish and Wildlife, Kathrine. Short time after, CCHS HMP was contacted by officer Goode from fish and Wildlife. A time was set up to meet officer Goode on Sunday to assess the incident and assist Fish and Wildlife with their procedure.

On April 22, 2017 at approximately 16:24 CCHS HMP was contacted by Contra Costa Fire Protection District Battalion Chief Lutzow. CCFPD had been dispatched to the scene from the OES report. CCHS HMP responded to the scene by CCFPD request.

Upon arrival at scene, CCHS HMP conducted an environmental investigation. CCHS HMP used a Combustible Gas Indicator, pH paper, Photoionization Detector and oxidizer paper. The results were as follows:

CGI: O2- 20.9; H2S-0; CO- 0; LEL-0

pH paper- neutral

PID- 0

Oxidizer paper- no change

A milky substance was observed in the creek. No odors were detected nor any dead biological organism observed.

The source of the substance was not found nor was the content. CCHS HMP determined the conditions to be non-hazardous.

On April 23, 2017 at approximately 11:00 am, CCHS HMP met with Officer Goode from Fish and Wildlife at the scene. CCHS HMP assisted Officer Goode in determining a source/content. Many potential construction sites were located around the water source, however no definitive source was found.
