

REPORT:								
CCHS HMP responded to drum of mixed chemicals in Bay Point. CCHS HMP found approx. 30 gallon drum full of unknown solid waste and 55 gallon of an unknown liquid waste. CCHS developed a site safety and control plan written by M. Hagen. CCHS HMP over-packed the 55 gallons of unknown liquid. A bill of lading was written for the waste and was transported to CCHS HMP hazardous waste storage area.								
On April 28th, 2017, two specialist returned for unknown solid waste. Waste was determined to be biological waste contained in 5 gallon paint containers. This waste was transported to CCHS hazardous waste storage area. The waste was transported on May 2, 2017 to Delta Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility.
