

TH contacted UP for more information. Spoke to Nate/ Dave. Apparent vapor release from one or more cars containing Sodium Sulfide. They have been isolated from the rest of the cars.

MD/DV respond to meet with UPRR Environmental Representative at the site. P. Holt.

Meeting with P. Holt, we all decide to investigate the 3 isolated cars from the upwind direction. With a multiRae, checked first 2 cars and they had no readings. On the third car, there were readings on the PID to indicate vapors were releasing from the car.

As a precaution, all 3 personnel don level C PPE and it was determined the vacuum relief valve needed to be replaced.

The rail car was depressurized, the vacuum relief valve removed, and a plug was installed to temporarily cap the hole. Monitoring indicated that there was no more product releasing.

The shipper was notified that they need to address the issue.
