

DV went straight to the scene, TA & MD took HM3 to the scene.

On scene, assessed the container was not leaking.

Briefed on safety considerations - traffic, ppe, monitoring prior to opening.

Took pH = 5 close to neutral. Volume was less than 1 gallon (closer to 1 cup) in a 5 gallon container.

CCHS-HMP placed the container in containment in HM3

Liquid was disposed of to sanitary and the container disposed of as solid waste.
