

- ~1625: HM2,3 Arrive on scene
- ~1700: CCHS-HMP air monitor at Grant Elementary School, 2400 Downer Ave with Drager HCL, Drager NO2, Cl gas badge. Results are negative for all monitors.
- ~1720: Health Officer approves lifting shelter in place for Grant Elementary School
- ~1735: CCHS-HMP request DTSC clean up contractor. ERER#: 2017-09-02
- ~1740: CCHS-HMP, DV, SD prepare to make entry: Site safety plan is developed, pre-entry briefing is held entry team over packs damaged 55 gal DM and cleans some contaminated dirt
