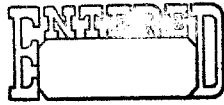

REPORT:

At approximately 9:00 AM, Mr. Michael Moore, Maintenance Supervisor, from City of Pleasant Hill contacted CCHSHMP. Mr. Moore stated that he was notified by his staff that there was a 55 poly drum containing unknown substances abandoned along the side of the road. His staff was notified by Pleasant Hill Police over the weekend.

HazMat 3 departed the bay at approximately 10:21 AM. HazMat 3 was on scene at approximately 10:31 AM. No storm drains were impacted. CCHSHMP used CGI and PID. CGI and PID indicated normal reading. No odor was noted. CCHSHMP observed clear liquid draw from the drum content. CCHSHMP conducted pH test, Oxidizer test, combustible test, and water solubility test. pH was between 5-6. The clear liquid was indicated negative on the Oxidizer test and not combustible nor flammable. The clear liquid was miscible in water. The clear liquid did not react the the normal air. CCHSHMP used Ahura and HazMat Elite devices. The two devices indicated "no results were found." Based on the detection devices and equipment, CCHSHMP assumed that the clear liquid inside the drum was "non hazardous." HazMat 3 departed the scene at approximately 10:52 AM.

CCHSHMP contacted Mr. Moore to inform about the new information the investigation. CCHSHMP informed Mr. Moore that the clear liquid inside the drum was "non hazardous" based on the detection devices and equipment. CCHSHMP informed Mr. Moore that it is safe for his staff to pick up the drum.
