

REPORT:

- 15:00 Resident Don Hinshaw calls CCHSHMP to report that about 1/2 cup of mercury was spilled onto his front porch located at 5814 Sutter Avenue in Richmond.
- 15:25 Specialist Adam Springer departs office in POV and Specialists Ian Williams and Devra Lewis depart office in HM1.
- 15:48 CCHSHMP at residence. With Jerome, no mercury is detected at the sidewalk, at the foot of the steps that lead to the patio, or as specialists approached the spilled mercury. Appeared mercury was in a glass container and the container was broken on the brick porch releasing the mercury.
- 15:52 CCHSHMP had a safety meeting, as documented in ICS Form 208. Specialists Springer and Williams began vacuuming up the mercury with the mercury vacuum and collecting the broken pieces of glass. Detections of mercury during vacuuming activities ranged between 0 24.0 ug/m3. The mercury, broken glass, and PPE were containerized in a 5-gallon bucket with a hazardous waste label. The highest reading of mercury in the area of the spilled mercury following vacuuming activities was 1.9 ug/m3.
- 16:32 CCHSHMP departed residence.
- 17:24 CCHSHMP arrived back at office.
