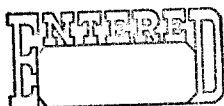

13:06 - Received page and call from ConFire Dispatch. About 30 gallons of diesel spilled due to a collision between and SUV and truck. CCHSHMP unable to reach BC Oakley.

13:09 - 7777s paged to activate IR Team to respond

13:16 - BC Oakley called HMS Devra Lewis - Saddle tank actively leaking from tow truck, diesel fuel diverted to the side, no storm drains impacted, unable to stop release

13:24 - HMS Lewis and HMS Ian Williams departed office in HM3. HMS Karine Abramians and HMS Sara Dwight departed office in HM1. HMS Tod Hickman going to scene in POV.

13:29 - HMS Xavier Bryant departed office in 6153

13:35 - HM1 and HM3 on scene. After brief safety meeting (see attached ICS 208), a pan was set under the saddle tank to catch the diesel, a fuel pump was set up, and additional absorbent was placed on the released diesel (tow truck and used absorbent and 2 pales to catch some diesel). CCHSHMP requested a sweeper to address the large area of absorbent on the spilled diesel.

14:50 - City of Concord Public Works arrived in sweeper. CCHSHMP observed/directed activities.

15:13 - CCHSHMP departed scene
