

Contra Costa Haz Mat was asked by Richmond Fire to assist identifying the content of an abandoned 15 to 20 gallon steel drum and if necessary helping to transport and dispose the drum.

After arriving at the scene, Contra Costa Haz Mat and Richmond Fire inspected and HazCat the unknown liquid and determined it was probably a high pH industrial detergent.

Based on the high pH and public access to the chemical, Richmond Fire contacted DTSC for an ERER number. DTSC assigned an ERER number and made arrangements with Richmond Fire to wait for the contractor to come dispose of the drum.
