1315 - CCHS-HMP HM3 (SH/CT) RESPONDED TO ABANDONMENT

1359 - HM3 ON SCENE MET WITH EBRPD POLICE OFFICER CASTANEDA. OFFICER CASTANEDA STATED THAT A HIKER FLAGGED HIM DOWN EARLIER TODAY INDICATING THAT A CONTAINER WAS FOUND ON A PARK TRAIL NEAR THE CREEK APPROXIMATELY ONE MILE FROM THE PARKING LOT.
