REPORT:

At approximately 12:11, CCHSHMP received a page from COMM-1. CCHSHMP contacted Capt. Shane Kelly. Capt. Kelly requested assistance on a small automotive oil leaking issue at the Round Table Pizza's parking lot in Lafayette. At approximately 12:20, CCHSHMP contacted MD and requested MD to be on scene to investigate the problem.

At approximately 12:45, MD was on scene and checked in with Capt. Shane Kelly - Station 17, B Shift. They had placed soil down to contain the leak. He advised MD that Lafayette PD has been notified. See photo of oil spill. Driver left note in dash that car was damaged and will get a tow truck in the morning. In the mean time, the vehicle leaked oil onto the parking space and it flowed into a low spot on the right of way .Cap t. Kelly left a message for the RP to call, as did MD- no response. Capt. Kelly also advised that a Tow truck was requested through law enforcement, but no ETA. Capt. Kelly was advised that the tow truck couldn't handle the vehicle if it was actively leaking. (leak was only a drip at this point). MD advised that if tow truck can handle spill, that should be good enough. If tow truck not able to handle, CCHS would bring out a rig with absorbent and take care of the issue. FD did not have absorbent on this particular rig.

Tow truck company arrived and had absorbent. Fire department assisted with containment/clean up. MD departed scene at 13:10.
