

White whisping in area of released pool chemicals is visible from upwind command center location. Captain Grant asked if there should be a shelter-in-place; HMS Lewis said no, but Shell Refinery and Martinez Water Treatment Plant personnel should be notified. Vehicle occupants are being triaged.
