

REPORT:

AT APPROXIMATELY 1504 HRS CCHS-HMP RECEIVED A CALOES SPILL REPORT INDICATING A 200 BARREL (APPROXIMATELY 8,400 GALLONS) CRUDE OIL SPILL INTO SECONDARY CONTAINMENT.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1505 HRS PLAINS PRODUCTS TERMINALS, SENIOR ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY COMPLIANCE AND SAFETY SPECIALIST, JOHN-PAUL NEPOTE CONTACTED CCHS-HMP TO OBTAIN PROVIDE SPILL / RELEASE NOTIFICATION AND INFORMATION. FACILITY CONTACTED US COAST GUARD, US EPA, AND CA DEPT. OF FISH AND WILDLIFE.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1530 HRS HMS UMEMOTO AND HMS TOUGERON RESPONDED TO THE SCENE.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1540 HRS HMS UMEMOTO AND HMS TOUGERON ARRIVED AT THE SCENE AND MET WITH MR. NEPOTE. MR. NEPOTE STATED THAT AT 1419 HRS AN OPERATOR OBSERVED OIL SPRAYING FROM A PIPELINE CONNECTED TO TANK 14 (TANK 14 CAPACITY STATED TO BE 500,000 BARRELS). THE OPERATOR NOTIFIED PLAINS PRODUCTS TERMINALS STAFF AND RELIEVED THE PIPELINE PRESSURE BY OPENING A VALVE AT ANOTHER LOCATION ON THE PIPELINE. ACCORDING TO MR. NEPOTE ALL SPILLED CRUDE OIL IS CONTAINED IN SECONDARY CONTAINMENT.

BASED ON VISUAL OBSERVATIONS THE CRUDE OIL IMPACTED APPROXIMATELY A 100 BY 50 FOOT SECTION BY TANK 14 AND APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET OF A SECONDARY CONTAINMENT DRAINAGE DITCH. ALL MATERIAL WAS OBSERVED TO BE IN SECONDARY CONTAINMENT

MR. NEPOTE STATED THAT PATRIOT ENVIRONMENTAL AND KM2 INDUSTRIES IS CURRENTLY CONDUCTING CLEANUP BY REMOVING THE FREE LIQUIDS. MR. NEPOTE INDICATED THAT THE FREE LIQUIDS WILL BE RETURN TO A STORAGE TANK AND CONTAMINATED SOILS WILL BE REMOVED, CHARACTERIZED, AND PROPERLY DISPOSED OF.
