

REPORT:

Jeremy Marsh of the Federal Fire Department contacted Contra Costa County Hazardous Materials
Programs (CCHS HMP) to report a spill of oil in a creek along Port Chicago Highway, north of
Highway 4 near the Military Ocean Terminal. Mr. Marsh reported 10-15 gallons of oil appeared to
have been spilled on the water and requested assistance with clean up.

CCHS HMP D. Vazquez, J. Pham, and S. Dwight responded to the scene and observed a small
amount of what appeared to be sheen on the surface of the water. No active leak or source was
observed so CCHS HMP conducted cleanup operations. CCHS HMP donned Level D PPE and
placed absorbant pads on the sheen.
