	DMINISTRATIVE UPDATE -Samir Shah MD, Chief Executive Officer and nief Medical Officer	
A	 CCRMC was named one of 231 hospitals in the country to receive a top-ranking in maternity care. The Medicare 1115 waiver ended June 30, 2020. It does not appear there will be a succession waiver. CCRMC anticipates receiving the full allotment of \$57.5 million; this will be finalized in October 2020. QIP (\$50-\$60 million)-the CMS Medicare/Medicaid managed care funding process continues. 40 metrics will be graded. CCRMC is net close to where it used to be on patient visits at this time last year. CCRMC is able to bill for phone calls and video visits. CCRMC has received \$20 million of CARES funding which helps replace the revenue loss. We are close to being balanced from a revenue standpoint. There is currently 30-day supply of PPE. CCRMC has had 20 staff test positive for COVID; 300 tested negative; 30 tests pending.
