Together, we create *life-changing* wishes for children with critical illnesses.




Our Chapter Locations

We granted 274 wishes in FY21. To ensure every eligible child receives a wish, we hope to grant 322 wishes by this time next year.



Why Wishes Matter

Wishes provide what medicine cannot – extraordinary and memorable experiences that make an illness the least of a child's worries, while a sense of normalcy comes into focus.

When a wish is granted, a child replaces:

Why A Wish?



98%

of medical providers said they have observed that the wish experience helps relieve families from traumatic stress related to their child's critical illness.



87%

of wish alumni said their wish gave them strength to fight their critical illness.



95%

of parents said they saw their child's *emotional well-being* improve through the wish experience.

90%


of medical providers said a wish increases a child's compliance with treatment.

of wish alumni said that their wish made them feel more joyful, confident and hopeful for their future.






Perception Challenges

Volunteer

Wish Granting—Adults are invited to attend our training sessions to become a wish granter and be part of making a wish come true.

Events Volunteering—At Make-A-Wish events, we have opportunities for adults and those under 18.

Office Volunteering—Spend a few hours each week working in our chapter office.

KFWK helps students discover philanthropy by creating and managing their own fundraising project from start to finish.
