Doxycycline Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (Doxy-PEP)

SUMMARY

To reduce sexually transmitted infections (STIs), Contra Costa Public Health recommends doxycycline post-exposure prophylaxis (doxy-PEP) counseling as part of the comprehensive sexual health counseling for men who have sex with men (MSM) and transgender women (TGW) who are living with HIV or taking HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP). In these groups, doxy-PEP has demonstrated significant effectiveness and tolerability in preventing gonorrhea, chlamydia, and syphilis.

Actions Requested of Healthcare Professionals:

- 1. **Offer doxy-PEP** (doxycycline 200mg within 72 hours of condomless sex), using shared decision making, to adult MSM and TGW living with HIV or on HIV PrEP and in the past year:
 - Have had a recent STI (chlamydia, gonorrhea, or syphilis) OR
 - Report condomless anal or oral sexual contact
- 2. **Recommend HIV PrEP** to <u>eligible</u> patients
- 3. Screen for gonorrhea and chlamydia at all anatomic sites of exposure
- 4. **Test for syphilis and HIV** (if not known to be living with HIV) every 3 months.
- 5. **Treat STIs** according to <u>standards</u> and inform patient that they will be contacted by Contra Costa Public Health for confidential patient and partner support services
 - Gonorrhea or chlamydia in the rectum among MSM and TGW with HIV or on HIV PrEP will be prioritized for public health follow-up
