You may be eligible...

PUBLIC ASSISTANCE

If you are 65 years or older, blind, or disabled and you are getting Supplemental Security Income/Security Income/State Supp. Program (SSI/SSP), you are automatically eligible for MEDI-CAL.

MEDICALLY NEEDY

You are Medically Needy if you are age 65 or older, blind, disabled, or you meet the family circumstances required for TANF.

MEDICALLY INDIGENT

You are Medically Indigent, if you are a pregnant woman or a child under the age of 21 with no linkage to a Public Assistance program; a refugee in the country 12 months or less; or a person age 21 to 65 in a skilled nursing intermediate care facility.

PREGNANT WOMEN

If you are pregnant and cannot afford to pay for health care, MEDI-CAL can help pay for medical expenses for you and your baby.

CHDP

If you or your child are under age 21 and on MEDI-CAL you may receive complete health check-ups including shots, hearing test and vision test from your doctor.

REFUGEES

If you are a refugee or entrant not qualified for the medically needy or medically indigent programs, you may qualify for the Refugee/Entrant Medical Assistance Program.

CHILDREN

Your child may get MEDI-CAL at no cost if your child is an infant, or between ages 1 – 18.

TANF

If you are getting Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), you may also be entitled to get MEDI-CAL benefits.

CONFIDENTIAL SERVICES

If you are 21 years of age or younger, unmarried, and living with your parents, you may be eligible to receive certain confidential medical services regardless of citizenship or immigration status.

Medical services include those, which relate to family planning, pregnancy, drug/alcohol abuse, sexually transmitted diseases (STD), sexual assault, and mental health.

EPSDT

You or your child may be able to get any service your doctor feels is medically necessary, even those not available to the general MEDI-CAL population.

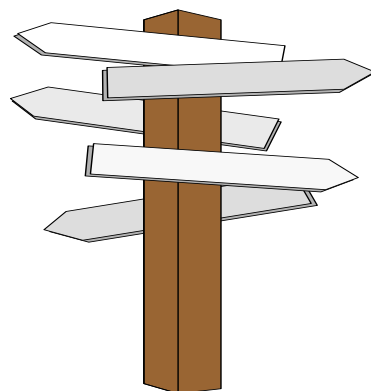

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The first place to start is Medi-Cal. If you are a U.S. citizen and answer “yes” to any of the following questions, you may qualify for Medi-Cal.

1. Are you under 21 years of age?
2. Do you have any children (including grandchildren, nieces, nephews, etc.) under 21 years of age living in your home, and is one parent dead, absent, disabled, incapacitated, or working less than 100 hours per month?
3. Are you 65 years of age or older?
4. Have you been determined to be legally blind?
5. Do you receive Social Security disability payments?
6. Has a physician determined you are unable to work because of physical or mental illness, disability, or impairment that is expected to last more than 1 year?
7. Have you applied for Social Security Disability or SSI/SSP within the last 6 months?
