Loan Repayment Program

Application Closes April 30th at 11:30pm, 2022

You may be eligible for a student loan repayment program if you are a Contra Costa Behavioral Health Services employee, including staff under Mental Health and Alcohol and Other Drug Services, OR work in a Contra Costa Behavioral Health Services contracted Community Based Organization providing services to clients in Contra Costa.

- Up to \$10,000 in eligible educational loan repayment to qualified providers for a 12-month service obligation.
- Must meet the minimum eligibility requirements in order to apply
- This Loan Repayment Program seeks to support diversity, equity and inclusion of qualified providers which make up the public behavioral health workforce and serve the most vulnerable populations within Contra Costa County in hard-to-fill/retain position

Personal lived experience is personal experience or having a close family member which at any point in their life has had mental health and/or substance use challenges, or systems involvement experience to include experience in the public behavioral health system, foster care system, or at any point in their life has been homeless.
