

In 2020 the Contra Costa Family Medicine Residency Program will sponsor two Point of Care Ultrasound (POCUS) courses:

Saturday, January 18th & Sunday, January 19th, 2020

Saturday, June 20th & Sunday, June 21st, 2020

Specifics: Priority enrollment is given to clinical faculty or residents interested in starting or developing a POCUS program in their Family Medicine Residency Program. Please see Schedule under Resources tab for an example of course content.

Participation in the course will allow you to receive 15 units CME (AAFP), 1 year of complete access to the longitudinal online video POCUS curriculum at [Global Ultrasound Institute](#) (and 20 units of AAFP CME), and a certificate of completion that can be utilized to get POCUS privileges at your home institution. The course will teach bedside ultrasound skills that are helpful for outpatient and inpatient physicians.

The hours of the courses will be 800am - 500pm on Saturday and 830am - 500pm on Sunday. The course will take place at the:

Payment: The course costs **\$749**. Similar courses by commercial vendors cost over \$1250. Receipt of payment will reserve you a spot in the course. Space is limited.
