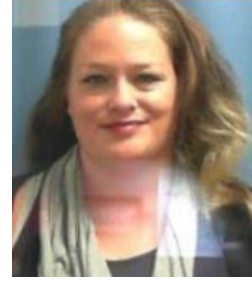


Mommo's Chex Party Mix and Pink Jello,

"Below are Mommo's Chex Mix (Mommo is what we called my Grandmother) and her Pink Jello. My family makes this for all the fall holidays, and it makes the house smell delicious."

6 tbsp. butter

4 tsp Worcestershire sauce

2 tsp. seasoned or garlic and onion salt and pepper (I use fresh diced garlic)

2 c. Rice chex

2 c. Corn chex

2 c. Wheat Chex

small pretzels/ pretzel sticks

*3/4 c. salted mixed nuts (optional)



You can add any other food you like such as bagel chips

Heat oven to 250 degrees. Melt butter in shallow pan over low heat. Stir in Worcestershire sauce and seasons salt. Add Chex and nuts. Mix over low heat until all pieces are coated. Heat in oven for 1 hour. Stir every 15 minutes. Spread out on absorbent paper to cool. We make this in much larger portions and always have a large

1-2 boxes of jello (we like raspberry)

16 oz cottage cheese

can of pineapple chunks

tub of whipped cream

cherries

Drain the pineapple completely. Mix cottage cheese and whipped cream. Stir in the pineapple. Mix in jello until completely dissolved top with cherries. chill overnight.
